The 23rd annual Emerald Cup Class Championships is here! Triton Yacht Club and Fern Ridge Reservoir can't wait for you to join us June 25th - 28th in Eugene, OR as we race the weekend away! You don't want to miss this year's event - all registered boats are entered to win a **\$500 door prize**.

The local Wavelength fleet (Fleet D) is inviting all sailors to join them at the neighboring yacht club clubhouse for a **steak dinner** and band on Friday to wrap up day one and get things started right! We have a **delectable buffet** planned for the whole Emerald Cup Saturday evening and tons of prizes to vie for in the raffle - we anticipate another generous year. The **festival atmosphere** along with a **tremendous sailing venue** makes this one of the top go-to regattas of the season. If you have never been to the Emerald Cup, now is the time to check it out. Lodging is available in Eugene or Junction City just minutes away, or if you prefer to camp, sites are available at Richardson Park right next the venue and right on the water. Richardson is also RV friendly, so bring the whole family.

The **NOR** and **Registration** information is available, and check out the **Schedule of Events** for an idea of what is planned! The **Wavelength 24** class rules are as follows:

- must carry outboard capable of propelling your boat. You CAN stow it below.
- we're not going to measure sails, BUT if someone protests your sails and they don't check out, you are DSO. This rule will apply to other non-factory modifications to spar length, materials, spin pole length, foils, etc. Existing configurations on boats in Fleet I will be allowed. Any 'Questionable Modifications' on new boats joining allowed by approval of majority of fleet only. Disputes over measurements and modifications will be decided by fleet vote.

We have some RV and tent camping available through TYC (contact Carrie Harrington at EmeraldCupChair@TritonYachtClub.org) and even some temporary moorage possibilities through the Marina - but space is limited so please contact as soon as you can. Campsites can hold (1) RV and (2) tents, or (3) tents total, so if you are camping as a group, please limit to (8) people per site. We will release unreserved sites on June 10th, so speak up as soon as possible.
